

Where mouth-watering meals cost eyewatering £1,200 a head in Ibiza

It promises to be the ultimate dining experience — and, at about £1,200 a head, it had better live up to the hype.

Sublimotion, dubbed the world's most expensive restaurant, will open on the Spanish island of Ibiza on June 1, offering a two-hour "gastro-sensory" experience for only one group of 12 at a sitting. The meal will consist of exotic snacks inspired by tastes from around the world, accompanied by fine wines.
